Application Form for Roster of Registered Court Interpreters

In order to be placed on the Roster of Registered Court Interpreters, an individual must speak a language for which no oral certification exam exists, yet the individual has passed the written exam with an 80 percent, has completed the orientation workshop, and has passed an oral English exam and other language proficiency assessment.

The Administrative Office of the Courts will conduct criminal history checks on all applicants prior to placement on the roster. See Section 3.2 of the Court Interpreter Program Policy Manual. Please attach a completed Authorization and Consent for Release of Information form.

As a member of the Consortium for State Court Interpreter Certification, the Idaho Administrative Office of the Courts has access to certification exams for the following languages: Arabic, Cantonese, French, Hatian-Creole, Hmong, Ilocano, Korean, Laotian, Mandarin, Portuguese, Russian, Serbian (abbreviated exam) Somali, Spanish, Turkish (abbreviated exam) and Vietnamese.
