This roster is for languages for which no interpretation exam exists and includes the names of persons who have passed a written screening exam with an 80% or better, attended a two-day orientation workshop, and have passed an oral English exam and other language proficiency assessment.

As a member of the Consortium for State Court Interpreter Certification, the Idaho Administrative Office of the Courts has access to certification exams for the following languages: Arabic, Bosnian Serbian, Croatian, Cantonese, French, Haitian-Creole, Hmong, Ilocano, Korean, Laotian, Khmer, Mandarin, Marshallese, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Somali, Spanish, Tagalog, Turkish and Vietnamese.
