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ORDER

The Court being fully informed, and having determined that in order to permit the courts in and for Ada County to begin using the Odyssey Case Management System on Monday, August 8, 2016, it will be necessary to suspend access to the Odyssey Case Management System in Twin Falls County on Friday, August 5, 2016, and that the District Court, Magistrate Division of the District Court, and Office of the Clerk of the District Court in and for Twin Falls County will therefore have no access to the Odyssey Case Management System on Friday, August 5, 2016, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the Supreme Court's authority and responsibility for the administration and supervision of the judicial system, that the District Court, Magistrate Division of the District Court, and Office of the Clerk of the District Court in and for Twin Falls County will be CLOSED on Friday, August 5, 2016, for all purposes other than essential judicial business relating to the public safety that must be transacted on that day;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Administrative District Judge of the Fifth Judicial District, the Trial Court Administrator of the Fifth Judicial District, and the Clerk of the District Court in and for Twin Falls County may make such provisions as they deem necessary and appropriate for addressing initial appearances in criminal cases for persons who are in custody, detention hearings in Juvenile Corrections Act cases for juveniles who are in custody, the issuing of arrest warrants and search warrants, the issuing of orders of detention pursuant to I.C. §

66-329, the issuing of ex parte orders in civil protection order cases, and such other matters as might demand immediate attention in the public interest, and that such matters may be addressed to the extent possible by an on-call magistrate judge in the same manner as such matters are addressed on weekends and holidays;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no filings will be accepted on August 5, 2016, by the Office of the Clerk of the District Court in any matters other than those relating to the public safety that need to be filed on that day; and, for purposes of computing and extending time under existing Idaho statutes and Court Rules (e.g. IRCP Rule 2.2 and ICR Rule 45), August 5, 2016 shall be deemed to be a "legal holiday/non-judicial day" in Twin Falls County, Idaho, extending any deadlines falling on August 5, 2016 to the close of business on Monday, August 8, 2016. Each affected court in Twin Falls County may adjust the schedule for responding in accordance with applicable rules.
