APPOINTMENT OF JURY COMMISSIONERS & EXCUSING OR POSTPONING JURY SERVICE

Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 2-205, a jury commissioner is established in each county to manage the jury selection process under the supervision and control of the Court. The jury commission shall be composed of the Clerk of the District Court and a Jury Commissioner(s) appointed by the Administrative District Judge. The Jury Commissioners shall serve until a successor is qualified and appointed.

For each of the Counties listed below, the Administrative District Judge hereby appoints the following individual(s) to serve as Jury Commissioner in addition to the Elected Clerk.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each said Jury Commissioner is hereby authorized to disqualify jurors in the jury commissioner's county pursuant to Idaho Code § 2-209, and is hereby authorized to excuse prospective jurors from service only under the following circumstances:

- 1. Physical illness
- 2. Physical illness of immediate family member where juror must provide care
- 3. Preplanned vacation or business trip of the juror
- 4. When prospective juror is a nursing mother
- 5. Currently attending college
- 6. Medical reasons with doctor's certificate
- 7. Temporarily residing outside the county for a period of thirty (30) days or more.

Any other request for excuse form jury service must be forwarded to the presiding judge of the scheduled trial for disposition, including the following, but not limited to.:

- 1. Request for preplanned medical appointments
- 2. Request due to financial hardship
- 3. Request due to religious beliefs
- 4. Request due to extreme hardship on the part of the juror or the juror's employer
- 5. Lack of Transportation of Juror

Said appointment and designation is effective immediately. Each juror commissioner shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified.

This Administrative Order No. 2021-01 replaces all previous administrative orders in regards to the appointment of jury commissioner and jury qualifications.
