ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NO. 21-09-22

Administrative Order No. 21-09-17 allowed jury trials to resume in Boise County and Valley County on September 27, 2021. That order also specified that the court would continue to assess the COVID-19 situation and could preclude jury trials by further order, if circumstances warranted. Jury trials were already suspended for that time period in Ada County and Elmore County.

As of yesterday, Boise County and Valley County's COVID-19 seven-day moving average incidence rate remained below the Idaho Supreme Court's threshold for not holding jury trials.¹ However, local and state-wide COVID-19 hospitalization and ICU admission rates are still very high and the number of ICU beds available are still extremely low.²

The lower numbers appear to continue to be attributable, in some part, to a delay in reporting.

According to the Director of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, hospital conditions in Idaho, already in crisis standards, are expected to worsen, at least in the near term.3

Exercising the discretion permitted to the Administrative District Judge in these circumstances,4 Administrative Order No. 21-09-17 is rescinded as to the resumption of jury trials in Boise County and Valley County. There will be no jury trials in the Fourth Judicial District for the calendar week of September 27, 2021.

As provided in the Supreme Court's Order, "the time used to calculate the right to a speedy trial pursuant to I.C. § 19-3501 shall be deemed to have been tolled for those counties affected by said order." Idaho Supreme Court's June 25, 2021 Amended Order Re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services, at 4.
