ORDER
NOVEMBER 25, 2020

As a result of the on-going reduction in court services caused by the COVID-19 virus, this Court finds it is necessary to increase the opportunities for parties to mediate civil cases, and NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. Active judges and senior judges may be assigned by the Administrative District Judge of a district to mediate civil cases.
2. Any senior judge assigned to mediate a civil case will be compensated as with any senior judge service. Any active judge assigned to mediate a case shall not receive any compensation in addition to his or her statutorily set salary.
3. The requirements of Idaho Court Administrative Rule 73 shall not apply to active or senior judges assigned by an Administrative District Judge to mediate civil cases until further order of this Court.
4. Any civil or administrative court rule in conflict with this order is suspended until further order of this court.
