**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
H20-BOU.2**

The First Judicial District, in an attempt to control the spread of the COVID-19 and reduce the risk of infection within the courts, the jail and the community, and to comply with the Idaho Supreme Court's Emergency Reduction In Court Services Order of March 26, 2020 is implementing the following.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. No defendants shall be ordered to engage in the Boundary County Sheriff Labor Program for the next fifty-one (51) days.
2. All current orders and judgments requiring defendants to perform Boundary County Sheriff Labor Program hours by a date certain are extended fifty-one (51) days.
3. All current orders and judgments requiring defendants to perform community service hours are extended for a period of fifty-one (51) days.
4. No Order allowing for Unscheduled Jail Time (UJT) for misdemeanor and felony probationers may be implemented during the next fifty-one (51) days.
