**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
H20-KOO.5**


The First Judicial District, in an attempt to control the spread of the COVID-19 and reduce the risk of infection within the courts, the jail and the community, and to comply with the Idaho Supreme Court's Emergency Reduction In Court Services Order of March 26, 2020 is implementing the following.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. No juvenile shall be ordered to engage in the Work in Lieu of Detention Program for the next fifty-one (51) days.
2. All current orders requiring defendants to perform Work in Lieu of Detention Program hours or community service hours by a date certain are extended fifty-one (51) days.
3. No Order allowing for Unscheduled Detention Time (UJT) for juvenile probationers may be implemented during the next fifty-one (51) days.
4. All admit/deny hearings for not-in-custody juveniles shall be set for hearing no sooner than fifty-one (51) days from the date of this Order.
5. All admit/deny probation violation hearings for not-in-custody juveniles shall be set for hearing no sooner than fifty-one (51) days from the date of this Order.

Nothing in this Order shall preclude the Administrative District Judge or presiding judge in a juvenile matter from vacating or continuing other scheduled matters in accordance with the Supreme Court's COVID-19 Order.
