ORDER

On March 25, 2020, for public safety and to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus, Idaho Health and Welfare Director Dave Jeppesen, at the direction of Governor Bradley J. Little, issued an Order to Self-Isolate for the State of Idaho. On March 26, 2020, and also in response to the COVID-19 virus, this Court entered its Order "In re: Emergency Reduction in Court Services and Limitation of Access to Court Facilities" requiring all State of Idaho court facilities to conduct reduced operations.

Section 4-101, Idaho Code establishes a state law library in the City of Boise for the use of the courts and members of the bar, and section 4-103, Idaho Code grants this Court control and management of the state law library.

NOW, THEREFORE, for public safety and to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus, IT IS ORDERED that the Idaho state law library is closed until further order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to this order, the State Law Librarian shall post a notice of other alternative sources that a citizen can use during closure, said notice to be placed on both entrances to the Idaho State Law Library building. Further, a copy of this order shall also be posted on both entrances to the Idaho State Law Library building.
