**ORDER CLARIFYING EFFECT OF
JANUARY 6, 2023, "ORDER RESCINDING
EMERGENCY ORDERS"**


This Court's February 17, 2022, Order re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services states in paragraph 6 that "[i]f this order is lifted, disqualification without cause rules will only operate prospectively to new cases and may not be exercised retrospectively in any existing case."

This Court's January 6, 2023, Order Rescinding Emergency Orders states that "[o]n April 1, 2023, this Court's February 17, 2022, Order re: Emergency Order Regarding Court Services shall be rescinded."

The rescission of the February 17, 2022, Order re: Emergency Order was not intended to eliminate that order's direction that the disqualification rules will only operate prospectively. Thus, effective immediately, the disqualification without cause rules shall only apply to cases commenced on or after April 1, 2023, and they may not be exercised in cases existing prior to April 1, 2023.


