ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER H20-KOO.2

The First Judicial District, in an attempt to control the spread of the COVID-19 and reduce the risk of infection within the courts, the jail and the community, is implementing the following.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. No defendant shall be ordered to engage in the Kootenai County Sheriff Labor Program for the next sixty (60) days.
- 2. All current orders and judgments requiring defendants to perform Kootenai County Sheriff Labor Program hours by a date certain are extended sixty (60) days.
- 3. All current order and judgments requiring defendants to perform community service hours are extended for a period of sixty (60) days.
- 4. No Order allowing for Unscheduled Jail Time (UJT) for misdemeanor and felony probationers may be implemented during the next sixty (60) days.
- 5. Preliminary hearings for not-in-custody defendants shall **not** be noticed for hearing for any time less than sixty (60) days from the date of this Order.
- 6. All admit/deny probation violation (misdemeanor and felony) hearings for not-in-custody defendants shall be set for hearing no sooner than sixty (60) days from the date of this Order.
