**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
H20-KOO.3**


The First Judicial District, in an attempt to control the spread of the COVID-19 and reduce the risk of infection within the courts, the jail, juvenile detention facility and the community, is implementing the following.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. No juvenile shall be ordered to engage in the Work in Lieu of Detention Program for the next sixty (60) days.
2. All current orders requiring defendants to perform Work in Lieu of Detention Program hours or community service hours by a date certain are extended sixty (60) days.
3. No Order allowing for Unscheduled Detention Time (UJT) for juvenile probationers may be implemented during the next sixty (60) days.
4. All admit/deny hearings for not-in-custody juveniles shall be set for hearing no sooner than sixty (60) days from the date of this Order.
5. All admit/deny probation violation hearings for not-in-custody juveniles shall be set for hearing no sooner than sixty (60) days from the date of this Order.

Nothing in this Order shall preclude the Administrative District Judge or presiding judge in a juvenile matter from vacating or continuing other scheduled matters in accordance with the Supreme Court's COVID-19 Order.
