The Court, continuing its efforts to improve the efficient and innovative practices of the appellate courts in Idaho, desires to appoint a committee to perform the following tasks:

- Examine current business processes within the Appellate Clerk's office to determine whether there are practices which can further improve timelines and accuracy
- Seek out experts to provide analysis of business processes and office management
- Formulate detailed business process plans to set forth practices which can then be implemented in the Odyssey appellate module
- Serve as a resource to Tyler Technologies for Idaho related processes, laws and configuration as Tyler moves forward with development of the appellate module, and approve any implementation of the module
- Take any other actions or make recommendations to the Supreme Court to improve the administration of the appellate courts

The Appellate Business Process Committee will meet regularly and report periodically to the Supreme Court on actions taken, as well as recommendations for further improvements.

Hon. John Melanson, Chief Judge, Court of Appeals


