The Court, having received a recommendation from Honorable Mark Ingram, Chair of the Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee, and in Coordination and consultation with Jason Dye, Statewide Juvenile Justice Services Managers;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a multidisciplinary Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee, in furtherance of Idaho's balanced approach to the juvenile justice system, accomplish the following:

- 1. Build collaboration with juvenile justice stakeholders;
- 2. Research and study the operation of Idaho's juvenile justice system to improve practices and outcomes for juveniles and their families;
- 3. Promote the implementation of evidence based practices to accomplish the goals of the Juvenile Corrections Act (JCA);
- 4. Recommended changes to rules or statutes to improve the operation of the juvenile justice system;
- 5. Assist with implementation of juvenile case flow management plans;
- Collaborate with the Supreme Court Drug Court and Mental Health Court Coordinating Committee to promote effective practices in Idaho's juvenile drug and mental health courts;
- 7. Collaborate with the Supreme Court Child Protection Committee to promote policies and practices aimed at improving outcomes for dually adjudicate (crossover) youth;
- 8. Develop, recommended, and maintain statewide juvenile justice forms; and
- 9. Promote the implementation of data sharing among system.
