ORDER

As established under Idaho Code §19-5109(9), the Misdemeanor Probation Training Council is an advisory group to the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Council, to advise POST Council in the planning, development and operation of basic training, continuing education, and certification standards for misdemeanor probation officers.


The Misdemeanor Training Council is comprised of a magistrate, two (2) county commissioners, three (3) misdemeanor probation department administrators, a representative of the Idaho Association of Counties, a representative of the Idaho Department of Correction and a representative of the Administrative Office of the Courts, which advises the Council in the planning, development, and operation of basic misdemeanor probation academies.

Magistrate Judge Brent Ferguson is appointed to serve on the Misdemeanor Probation Training Council for a three-year term beginning January 1, 2026.

Sandy Jones, Senior Program Manager, will serve as the representative of the Administrative Office of the Courts for a three-year term beginning January 1, 2026.
