In FY2020, the Idaho Supreme Court launched courtdata.idaho.gov to present a range of information about Idaho's state courts.

The website provides citizens and decision-makers independent access to court financial and filing data. This allows them to:

- Better understand court functions and money disbursement, including the different ways money can be distributed based on the initiating jurisdiction.
- Review data regarding court financials and filings in various forms such as annual measures, maps, and charts.

The site is an example of the Judicial Branch's dedication to transparent administration of Idaho's courts.

IMPROVEMENTS

As of the 2022 session, the site has received a complete overhaul. It now contains improved tables and charts that provide a more comprehensive view of data on specific topics and make it easier to see a full statewide picture.

Moving off of the Socrata platform, the revised site allows greater flexibility in how you can sort and display data, and a more interactive data exploration experience. As before, it provides information on a variety of criminal and civil case types and court finances.

Importantly, the purpose and breadth of the website are unchanged. The upgrade laid groundwork for future potential growth, resulting in a dynamic site that can be enhanced with additional data measures in the future.
