ORDER

On March 26, 2020, this Court entered an Order "In re: Emergency Reduction in Court Services and Limitation of Access to Court Facilities" requiring all State of Idaho court facilities to conduct reduced operations through April 15, 2020. On April 14, 2020, this Court entered an Order "In re: Extension of Emergency Reduction in Court Services and Limitation of Access to Court Facilities" extending the operative dates of the March 26th Order for an additional week, through April 22, 2020.


All Supreme Court hearings scheduled during the month of May 2020 will be conducted via Zoom video conferencing, on the date and time currently set for oral argument. The Clerk's Office will be in contact with counsel for the parties to set up the remote oral argument. The Zoom oral and video presentation will be archived by the Clerk's Office. This Order will be posted on the Idaho Supreme Court website, and a copy of the Order will be sent to the Idaho State Bar for dissemination to all attorneys.
