ORDER
December 23, 2025

On December 22, 2025, Governor Brad Little extended two additional paid holidays, December 24 and 26, 2025, to all state employees. Idaho Court Administrative Rule 44(a)(14) dictates that “[e]very day appointed by the President of the United States or the Governor of the state of Idaho for a public fast, thanksgiving or holiday” shall be a nonjudicial day for the state of Idaho. Therefore, this Court ORDERS that December 24 and 26, 2025, are nonjudicial days for the state of Idaho and the Idaho courts shall not conduct judicial business or attend their courts, except as permitted by Idaho Court Administrative Rule 44(b).

This Court further ORDERS that any filing or payment due to the Idaho courts by December 24 or 26, 2025, shall be deemed timely filed or received if filed or made by Monday, December 29, 2025.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
