

Idaho Court Administrative Rule (I.C.A.R.) 52(f) Interpreter Written Oath

Pursuant to I.C.A.R. 52(f), all court interpreters on a roster maintained by the Supreme Court Administrative Office of the Courts must complete a written oath. The written oath (below) is filed with the Administrative Office of the Courts and is in effect for two years unless an interpreter is removed under I.C.A.R. 52(g).
