







IDAHO SUPREME COURT
2012 PRIORITY OF PAYMENTS TO BE ORDERED AT SENTENCING

1. \$17.50 court costs for felonies and misdemeanors (\$12.50 distributed 86% to general fund and 14% to P.O.S.T. Fund, and \$5.00 to district court fund; if magistrate court facilities are provided by the city, then \$10.00 distributed 86% to general fund and 14% to P.O.S.T. Fund, \$5.00 to city general fund and \$2.50 to city capital facilities fund) (I.C. § 31-3201A(2)).

\$16.50 court costs for infractions (\$11.50 distributed 86% to general fund and 14% to P.O.S.T. Fund, and \$5.00 to district court fund; if magistrate court facilities are provided by the city, then \$9.00 distributed 86% to general fund and 14% to P.O.S.T. Fund, \$5.00 to city general fund and \$2.50 to city capital facilities fund) (I.C. § 31-3201A(3)).

2. Victims' Compensation Account (I.C. § 72-1025): Unless the court makes a finding of inability to pay, \$37.00 fine or reimbursement for each misdemeanor count; \$75.00 fine or reimbursement for each felony count. In addition to the \$37.00 misdemeanor and \$75.00 felony fine or reimbursement, there is a fine or reimbursement of not less than \$300.00 per count for any conviction or finding of guilt for any sex offense, including, but not limited to, offenses under I.C. §§ 18-1506, 18-1507, 18-1508, 18-1508A, 18-6101, 18-6108, 18-6605, and 18-6608.
3. Peace Officer and Detention Officer Temporary Disability Fund (I.C. § 72-1105): Unless the court makes a finding of inability to pay, \$3.00 fine for each felony or misdemeanor count.
4. State probation or parole supervision fee (I.C. § 20-225) or work release reimbursement to county jails (I.C. § 20-614).
5. Restitution to crime victim. (I.C. § 19-5302).
6. Emergency surcharge fee (I.C. § 31-3201H): a fee of \$100.00 for each felony count, \$50.00 for each misdemeanor count, and \$10.00 for each infraction .
7. \$10.00 ISTARs technology fee. (I.C. § 31-3201(5))
8. Victim Notification Fund Fee (I.C. § 31-3204): \$10.00 for each felony and misdemeanor count.
9. Community service fee (I.C. § 31-3201C).
10. County misdemeanor probation supervision fee. (I.C. § 31-3201D)
11. \$15.00 P.O.S.T. Academy fee. (I.C. § 31-3201B)

12. Domestic Violence Court fee. For persons who are found guilty of the offenses specified in I.C. § 32-1410, a \$30.00 fee to be deposited in the Statewide Drug Court, Mental Health Court and Family Court Services Fund.
13. Statutory reimbursement of public defender costs. (I.C. § 19-854(c))
14. Costs of prosecution ordered as condition of probation. (I.C. § 19-2601)
15. \$10.00 domestic violence fine. For persons who violate a domestic violence protective order (a misdemeanor), the first \$10.00 of the criminal fine is to be distributed to the domestic violence project account (I.C. § 39-5212), as provided in I.C. § 39-6312.
16. Criminal fine.
17. Presentence Investigation Fee (I.C. § 19-2516): In those cases in which a presentence investigation is ordered, an amount up to \$100.00 to be determined by the Department of Correction.
18. \$10.00 Drug Hotline Fee. For persons who violate the provisions of title 37, chapter 27, a \$10.00 fine to be deposited in the Drug Enforcement Donation Fund (I.C. § 57-816), as provided in I.C. § 37-2735A.
19. Additional \$7.50 fine for fish and game violations (I.C. § 36-1405), to be deposited to the search and rescue account (I.C. § 67-2913).
20. \$10.00 county administrative surcharge fee on each criminal case, \$5.00 on each infraction, for deposit to the county justice fund (I.C. § 31-4602), or to county current expense fund where no county justice fund has been established. (I.C. § 31-3201)
21. \$15.00 surcharge on DUI and DWP convictions or withheld judgments, for deposit in the court interlock device and electronic monitoring device fund. (I.C. § 18-8010)
22. For convictions or withheld judgments for violations of title 37, chapter 27, or for racketeering (I.C. § 18-7804) or money laundering (I.C. § 18-8201), restitution pursuant to court order for law enforcement costs incurred. (I.C. § 37-2732(k))
23. Restitution of no less than \$50.00 for the repair or replacement of simulated wildlife, to be paid by persons pleading or found guilty of attempting to take simulated wildlife. (I.C. § 36-1101(b)(7))
24. \$150.00 Abandoned Vehicle Fee for infractions in violation of I.C. § 49-1802, to be transmitted to the Abandoned Vehicle Trust Account created by I.C. § 49-1818. (I.C. § 31-3201F)

How the Fees Are Distributed

1. Court Costs – Felonies and Misdemeanors: \$17.50; Infractions: \$16.50

For felonies and misdemeanors, \$12.50 is sent to the state and is distributed 86:14 between the state General Fund and the Police Officer Standards and Training (POST) Fund. \$5.00 is deposited in the County District Court Fund. If the magistrate court facilities are provided by the city, \$5.00 is paid to the city's General Fund, \$2.50 to the City Capital Facilities Fund and \$10.00 is split 86:14 between the state General Fund and the POST Fund.

For infractions, the amount sent to the state for distribution between the General Fund and the POST Fund is \$1.00 less.

2. County Justice Fund -- \$10.00

This fee is deposited in the County Justice Fund which may be created pursuant to I.C. § 31-4602 or, if no such fund has been created in that county, in the current expense fund.

3. POST -- \$15.00

This fee is deposited in the Police Officer Standards and Training (POST) Fund.

4. Crime Victims Compensation

A \$75 fine is assessed for each felony, a \$37 fine for each misdemeanor, and an additional fine of \$300 or more for each sex offender. These fines are deposited in the Crime Victims Compensation Account to compensate victims of crime.

5. ISTARS -- \$10.00

This fee is deposited in the Idaho Statewide Trial Court Automated Records System Technology Fund, which is used for the purpose of maintaining, replacing and enhancing ISTARS and other technologies that assist in the efficient management of the courts.

6. Peace Officer Disability Fund -- \$3.00

This fee is deposited in the Peace Officer and Detention Officer Temporary Disability Fund and is used "for the purpose of providing a full rate of salary for any peace officer or detention officer who is injured while engaged in

those activities . . . and is thereby incapacitated from performing his or her duties.”

7. Emergency Surcharge – Felonies: \$100.00; Misdemeanors: \$50.00; Infractions: \$10.00

80% is deposited in the Drug Court, Mental Health Court and Family Court Services Fund; 20% is deposited in the ISTARs Technology Fund.

8. Victim Notification Fund -- \$10.00

This fee is deposited in the State Victim Notification Fund created by I.C. § 67-2912. The funds are used to defray the cost of administering the Statewide Automated Victim Information and Notification (SAVIN) system.

9. Interlock Fee -- \$15.00

This fee is deposited in the Court Interlock Device and Electronic Monitoring Device Fund, and the funds may be used for the purchase of ignition interlock devices and electronic monitoring devices, to assist an indigent defendant to procure an ignition interlock device or electronic monitoring device, or for alcohol or drug abuse related probation, treatment or prevention programs for adults or juveniles.

10. Community Service Fee -- \$0.60/hour

This fee is remitted to the State Insurance Fund for the purpose of providing worker's compensation insurance for persons providing community service, unless the county is self-insured.

11. Felony Probation Supervision Fee -- \$75.00/month or less

This fee is deposited in the Probation and Parole Receipts Fund which is “utilized to provide supervision for clients.” I.C. § 20-225.

12. Misdemeanor Probation Supervision Fee -- \$75.00/month or less

\$1.00 of each monthly payment is sent to the POST Fund to help offset the costs to counties for the training and continuing education of misdemeanor probation officers. The rest of these fees are deposited in the County Misdemeanor Probation Fund or, at the option of the Board of County Commissioners, in the County Justice Fund.

13. Drug and Mental Health Court Fee -- \$300.00/month or less

This fee is deposited in the County Drug Court, Mental Health Court and Family Court Services Fund and is expended for expenses incurred in connection with drug courts and mental health courts.

14. Domestic Violence Fine -- \$10.00

\$10.00 of a fine assessed for violating a civil protection order is deposited in the Domestic Violence Project Account and is used for grants for domestic violence projects and to meet the costs of maintaining the operation of the Council on Domestic Violence and Victim Assistance.

15. Drug Hotline Fee -- \$10.00

This fee is deposited in the Drug and Driving While Under the Influence Enforcement Donation Fund to support a 24-hour anonymous hotline and reward system for the reporting of drug violations.

16. Domestic Violence Court Fee -- \$30.00

This fee is deposited in the Drug Court, Mental Health Court and Family Court Services Fund to assist in funding the domestic violence courts.

17. Presentence Investigation Fee -- \$100.00 or less

This fee is deposited in the Probation and Parole Receipts Account and is used to reimburse the cost of conducting presentence investigations and preparing the presentence report.

DISTRICT COURT FILING FEES

COMMENCING A CIVIL ACTION

A civil action is commenced by filing a complaint, petition, application, or other document that begins a new civil lawsuit. A civil action is commenced if the clerk opens a new case file rather than filing the document in an existing case file. Whether a filing fee is charged does not depend upon the title or name of the document filed, but upon whether it commences a new case.

In a civil lawsuit, a party usually seeks to obtain an order or judgment from the court against another party. However, there are some times when a clerk will have to file a document, such as registering a trust, when it will not commence a lawsuit. In such instances, no filing fee will be charged.

Only one filing fee is charged even if the complaint, petition, or application includes two or more separate claims for relief. If the claims would have differing filing fees if they were filed as separate actions, then the appropriate fee is whichever is higher; for example, if one action was filed to have a marriage annulled or, if that were denied, to obtain a divorce, the appropriate filing fee would be the fee for filing a divorce action because it is higher than the filing fee for an annulment. Likewise, if one action was filed to compromise a minor's claim and to appoint a conservator, the appropriate filing fee would be for the appointment of a conservator.

The fee for opening any civil case not found on this schedule is \$96.00, and the correct filing fee code is "A".

APPEARING IN A CIVIL ACTION (Category I)

An appearance is the first document filed by a party (other than the plaintiff or petitioner) in an existing civil action, regardless of whether it is filed *pro se* or through counsel and regardless of the title of the document (e.g., "notice of appearance," "answer," "motion," or other title).

If a party acting *pro se* has already filed an appearance in an action and then an attorney later files a "notice of appearance" to appear on behalf of that party, the attorney's "notice of appearance" does not constitute an appearance for the purpose of assessing a filing fee because the party has already appeared in the action *pro se*.
