

## Leveled Registration

Based on information received from the Idaho State Sex Offender Registry, we have extrapolated information for a sampling of what initial Leveled Registration might look like using the current outlines and available data. The data includes a total of approximately 3,838 individual registrants in the state of Idaho, some of which have multiple associated crimes.

Using the crime indicated on the registration as the primary categorization and removing those with multiple entries, prior to applying the risk variables results in:

Category A	Category B	Category C	Category D	Category E

Registrants that have multiple entries totaled 710. Some of these registrants have only one additional entry; others have 3 or more crime code entries.

Approximately 399 registrants would be placed automatically into Category E by crime alone. This number is subjective, as all the information necessary is not readily available. These are a part of the 710 with multiple crime code entries, so they are placed into the Category E regardless.
