A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE TEMPORARY JOINT
RULES OF THE FORTY-FIRST IDAHO LEGISLATURE BY THE
ADOPTION OF A NEW JOINT RULE 18.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the House of Representatives and the Senate that a new temporary joint rule 18 be adopted relating to statements of purpose and fiscal notes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein, that the temporary joint rules of the legislature be amended by the addition of a new joint rule 18 to read as follows:

JOINT RULE 18

STATEMENTS OF PURPOSE AND FISCAL NOTES

No bill shall be introduced in either House unless it shall have attached thereto a concise statement of purpose. No bill making an appropriation, increasing or decreasing existing appropriations, or requiring a future appropriation, or increasing or decreasing revenues of the state or any unit of local government, or requiring a significant expenditure of funds by the state or a unit of local government, shall be introduced unless it shall have attached thereto a fiscal note. This note shall contain an estimate of the amount of such appropriation, expenditure or change under the bill. Statements of purpose and fiscal notes may be combined in the same statement.
