Webinar—Firearm Restrictions/Relief *** Date changed from July 10 to August 1***

A training webinar is set for August 1, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. Mountain Time to discuss with court staff a grant project to clean up reporting on earlier cases that should have a firearm restriction and/or relief from a restriction. The grant (2013 Idaho State Police NARIP Grant - NICS Act Record Improvement Program) provides funding to address missing, incomplete, and/or updated data elements needed within ISTARs to correctly report criteria to the FBI. Project instructions and details, including wages to be paid to deputy clerks for work completed under the grant, will be discussed. Case types included will be: hospitalization cases involving involuntary commitments (mental illness), or adult incapacitated persons appointed a conservator or guardian. These cases will need review and may need additional data entry from information on file with the court or from an involved party such as the prosecutor, public defender, law enforcement, conservator, guardian, and/or attorney. During the webinar, other court practices on these case types, plus firearms restriction clarification, will be addressed.

Court clerks who may be interested in working on the project should participate. If your court calendar can't accommodate participation in the webinar by all interested clerks, please include clerks who could train others after the webinar.
