

Important Information about Flexible Spending Accounts

This is a reminder that for the FSA account there is a 75-day grace period. This means that you may incur Medical Expenses and Employment-Related Dependent Care Expenses until September 13, 2012 and they will be deemed to have been incurred during the FY2012 plan year. **All claims must be submitted by October 31, 2012.** If they are not submitted by that date, you will not be reimbursed for those expenses.
