Introduction to Idaho Juvenile Offender System (IJOS)

Idaho Juvenile Offender System (IJOS) is a statewide tracking system created by the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections, as required by legislative mandate in the Juvenile Corrections Act of 1995. The goal is to reduce duplication and better track juvenile offenders in Idaho by allowing Juvenile Justice Staff (stakeholders) an application to access and share common information.

The System, free of charge and supported by the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections, provides an automatic back up of information. Even if your computer crashes, IJOS can be reloaded and all information will be available for continued use. It supports juvenile probation and detention compliance with annual audits and the data is very helpful when applying for grants. [Please enjoy the PowerPoint introduction to IJOS.](#)
