


Best Practice Rule for Amended Statutes:

At IICM the topic of how to enter an amended statute in ISTARs came up. As a result of that conversation there is some brainstorming going on to examine setup and process' to see if we can make ISTARs more user friendly in this regard- to the court user, and reporting systems in place. You may, in the future, see some changes to the ISTARs system to help accommodate that process in a better way.

Until that is determined and completed, and further instructions come out to you please use the following protocol when entering an amended statute in ISTARs. At least if we all do it the same way for now we'll be able to know what the original charge was and what the sentenced charge was if amended to a different charge. 😊

Enter all Amendments to an original charge in the Amended Statute line for the charge.



Even if there is a second or 3rd amended statute given to the clerk for that charge as the case works it's way through the system.

By so doing you should be getting the automatic ROA listing **for each subsequent amendment** to the charge displaying on the ROA the sequence and process **AND** we will know what the ISTARs data is telling us in a more consistent way.

Reminder: ISTARs DATA-

Statue – will always be the original statute.

Amended Statute - will be the amended statutes provided for that charge as they come in.
