


COURT NOTIFICATIONS BY PHONE AND/OR E-MAIL

As of June this year, an Idahoan can register to receive notification of court proceeding by phone or e-mail at 1-866-9VINE-ID or visiting www.vinelink.com .

The Statewide Automated Victim Information Notification (SAVIN) service known as VINE receives data from the Idaho State Repository. When there is a change in the court status, a message is sent to the registered party. While the service is designed to provide notification to victims, it is anonymous therefore anyone can register. Registrations are attached to case numbers so a person needs to register for each case number s/he is interested in.



Idaho VINE is also connected to all but one of the state's county jails and DOC enabling the public to search one site for an offender in custody. Using the toll free number and website above, a person can also register to be notified of an offender's custody release or transfer. Data is collected every 15 minutes from the jails resulting in near real time victim notification of an offender's release.

Managed by the Idaho Sheriffs' Association, the service is funded by two Bureau of Justice grants 2010-DJ-BX-0307 and 2010-CV-XN-0010, making it free to the public.
