

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Hall, Docket Nos. 31528/41059

Erick Virgil Hall was convicted of first-degree murder, first-degree kidnapping, and rape. He was sentenced to death for murder and to consecutive, fixed life terms for first-degree kidnapping and rape. Hall petitioned for post-conviction relief, alleging numerous errors at trial. Hall's petition for post-conviction relief was summarily dismissed. Hall's direct and post-conviction appeals are consolidated pursuant to Idaho Code section 19-2719(6). The Supreme Court affirms the judgments of conviction and the order dismissing the post-conviction petition.
