

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Daniel Edward Ehrlick, Jr., Docket No. 39249

In an appeal from Ada County, the Supreme Court upheld Daniel Edward Ehrlick, Jr.'s convictions for first-degree murder and failure to report a death to law enforcement finding that the district court did not err by admitting certain evidence and that the prosecution did not violate Ehrlick's right to a fair trial by committing acts of prosecutorial misconduct. Although the Supreme Court found that the district court erred by admitting testimony from an expert witness regarding the credibility of witnesses and by allowing inadmissible hearsay from a witness, it determined that in both instances the error was harmless.
