

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Serrano v. Four Seasons Framing, Docket No. 40970

In an appeal from the Industrial Commission of the State of Idaho, the Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the Industrial Commission's decision denying Serrano additional worker's compensation benefits because he failed to prove that the condition for which he claimed benefits was caused by his industrial accidents. The Supreme Court also held that the Commission did not err in admitting the post-hearing deposition testimony of employer's medical expert or in failing to augment the record on appeal with audio recordings that did not exist. Based upon these holdings, the Court declined to address constitutional claims that Serrano presented.
