

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Shubert v. Macy's West, Inc., Docket No. 41467

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the Idaho Industrial Commission's order that determined LuAnn Shubert's entitlement to benefits from Macy's West ("Macy's") and Liberty Insurance Corporation ("Liberty") after Shubert fell while working at a Macy's store. The Commission determined Shubert's medical stability date and found that based on that date, Shubert was not entitled to ongoing medical care or temporary disability benefits. The Commission also found Shubert was entitled to a 10% permanent partial disability rating. The Idaho Supreme Court held that substantial and competent evidence supported the Commission's order. The Court also affirmed the Commission's denial of Shubert's motion to reconsider.
