

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Syringa Networks, LLC v. Idaho Dep't of Admin., Docket No. 43027

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed a decision of the Ada County district court voiding two 2009 contracts made by the Idaho Department of Administration to procure telecommunication services and equipment for the Idaho Education Network. The Court held that a contract between the Department and ENA Services, LLC, as well as one made between the Department and Qwest Communications, LLC, were both void because they violated Idaho procurement law. Shortly after both contracts were issued, they underwent substantial changes to the scope of work to be done by ENA and Qwest thereby violating Idaho contracting laws.
