

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Clark, Docket. No. 44123

The Supreme Court affirmed the Ada County district court's denial of a motion for judgment of acquittal. The Court concluded that the State presented competent evidence that James Clark refused to depart from the Industrial Commission building after first being notified verbally by an authorized agent of the owner of the Industrial Commission building to immediately depart from the building. The Court also held that, to succeed on a constitutional challenge, Clark was required to demonstrate the statute as applied to him was unconstitutional, and he failed to do so.
