

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Seward v. Musick Auction, LLC

The Supreme Court affirmed the decision of the Canyon County district court to enforce the terms of an oral settlement agreement between Kevin Seward and Musick Auction, LLC (Musick). Musick appealed the district court's decision and argued to the Court that the district court erred by: (1) improperly relying on court minutes, (2) making impermissible credibility determinations, and (3) incorrectly granting Seward's motion to enforce the oral settlement agreement. The Supreme Court found that the district court had not erred and had properly enforced the settlement agreement because the parties had formed an enforceable oral agreement. The Court also awarded attorney fees to Seward pursuant to Idaho Code section 12-121.
