

## SUMMARY STATEMENT

*Thumm v. State*, Docket No. 45290

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed a district court judgment that granted the State's motion for summary disposition of Vance Thumm's petition for post-conviction relief. The case arose in 2009 when a jury convicted Thumm of aggravated battery or aiding and abetting aggravated battery and of being a persistent violator of the law. Thumm pursued a direct appeal, but was unsuccessful. In 2013, through counsel, Thumm petitioned for post-conviction relief alleging: (1) ineffective assistance of counsel at trial, sentencing, and on appeal; (2) a *Brady* violation; (3) prosecutorial misconduct; and (4) cumulative error. The State responded by filing a motion for summary disposition. The district court granted the State's motion and dismissed the post-conviction petition. In a unanimous decision, the Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court's judgment.
