SUMMARY STATEMENT

IDJC v. Dudley, Docket No. 46627

After John Doe was committed to the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections ("IDJC"), the magistrate court ordered Doe's father, Dennis Dudley, to reimburse IDJC for expenses incurred in caring for and treating Doe, pursuant to Idaho Code section 20-524(1). The reimbursement order, however, stated Dudley was not required to make any payments until further review by the magistrate court. The Idaho Supreme Court found no evidence in the record establishing what amount, if any, Dudley was ultimately ordered to pay to IDJC. As a result, the Court dismissed the appeal, holding the reimbursement order was not a final appealable order.
