SUMMARY STATEMENT

McCandless v. Pease, Docket No. 46936

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the Nez Perce County district court's order granting in part Dana McCandless and Mabel Blackeagle's motion for a new trial. McCandless and Blackeagle were injured and their property was damaged in a motor vehicle collision caused by Max Pease and Brent Weddle. A jury found Pease and Weddle negligent and awarded damages as a result. Dissatisfied with the amount of the verdict, as well as several other issues, McCandless and Blackeagle moved for a new trial. The district court granted their motion in part and ordered a new trial, subject to an additur in the amount of \$4,000. The Supreme Court affirmed, holding that the district court did not abuse its discretion.
