

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Hayes, Docket No. 47324

Michael Theron Hayes appealed his judgment of conviction from Ada County district court. A jury convicted Hayes of felony battery on a correctional officer.

The Supreme Court affirmed Hayes' conviction. The Supreme Court held that the district court did not err in declining to issue Hayes subpoenas for two medical professionals because Hayes' request was untimely. Further, the Supreme Court held that the district court did not err in admitting evidence of Hayes' prior instances of conduct on cross examination. While the prior instances of conduct were not admissible under Rule 608(b), Hayes failed to provide an alternative basis to exclude relevant evidence. Additionally, the Supreme Court held that the district court did not err in denying Hayes' motion for a new trial.
