SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Ahmed, Docket No. 47521

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court. The Court held the district court properly affirmed the magistrate court's denial of Ahmed's motion to dismiss because the domestic violence court process employed in Ada County did not violate Ahmed's right to due process and Idaho Code section 39-6312 does not violate separation of powers. The Court also held the district court properly affirmed the magistrate court's: 1) evidentiary ruling because of harmless error; 2) jury instruction because intent is not an element of violating a protection order; and 3) sentence. Finding no errors, the Court declined reversing Ahmed's conviction under the cumulative error doctrine.
