

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Alvarenga-Lopez, Docket No. 47914

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed a district court's denial of Kelvin Alvarenga-Lopez's motion to suppress because the initial encounter between the officer and Alvarenga-Lopez was consensual. The Court concluded that after Alvarenga-Lopez pulled over and parked the vehicle he was driving on his own accord, the officer could lawfully approach him and ask questions without a seizure occurring.
