SUMMARY STATEMENT

Hayes v. Medioli, Docket No. 47918

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court's decision that the magistrate court did not abuse its discretion when it granted Medioli's petition to change his minor son's name, finding the magistrate court correctly applied the "right and proper" standard enunciated in Idaho Code section 7-804. The Court reversed and vacated the district court's attorney fee award. The Court declined awarding fees on appeal but awarded costs as a matter of right to Medioli.
