

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Robirds v. Robirds

Docket No. 48414

This appeal originated from a divorce between Terrance (“Terry”) and Xiomara Robirds. The district court, on intermediate appeal, affirmed the decision of the magistrate court to (1) set aside a stipulated judgment regarding property distribution and (2) characterize all of Terry’s retirement accounts as community property, to be divided equally as of the date of divorce. Terry appealed. The Supreme Court affirmed the district court’s decision upholding the magistrate court’s decision that (1) set aside the Property Settlement portion of the Decree; (2) found the Halliburton, ConocoPhillips, and BP/Fidelity retirement accounts to be community property and, thus, equally divided; and (3) declined to award attorney fees to Terry.
