

## SUMMARY STATEMENT

*State v. Tower*, Docket No. 48748

Aaron Shane Tower appeals from the district court's order denying his motion to suppress evidence obtained following a warrantless arrest. Tower argued he was unlawfully arrested for trespassing without probable cause or a warrant, thus, the evidence obtained during a subsequent search should have been suppressed. Tower's appeal was first heard by the Idaho Court of Appeals, which affirmed his conviction. Tower then petitioned for review by the Idaho Supreme Court, which was granted. The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court's decision to deny Tower's motion to suppress because Tower did not properly preserve his argument on appeal.
