

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State of Idaho v. Jack Lee Rinebarger

Docket No. 49883

In this case arising out of Ada County, the Court of Appeals affirmed Jack Lee Rinebarger's judgment of conviction and unified sentence of fifteen years, with a minimum period of confinement of ten years, for first degree kidnapping and consecutive, unified sentence of five years, with a minimum period of confinement of one year, for aggravated assault. The Court of Appeals held that the district court did not abuse its sentencing discretion and rejected Rinebarger's argument that the district court discounted the mitigating factors as insignificant or unimportant because of the nature of Rinebarger's criminal conduct.
