This appeal arises out of violations to the University of Idaho, College of Law's honor code. During her third year, Laurie Barton was charged with violating the honor code after she allegedly committed academic misconduct during a final examination. Barton denied the allegations during the Honor Court proceedings, but the Honor Court found Barton committed academic misconduct and sanctioned her with degree denial. Barton exhausted administrative review, including an appeal to the Idaho State Board of Education and a petition for judicial review. While her petition for judicial review proceeded to a hearing, it was ultimately denied. Barton later stipulated to dismiss an appeal of the petition's denial. Instead, Barton sued the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho and Idaho State Board of Education, alleging nine causes of action, all of which the district court dismissed at summary judgment. The district court also denied Barton's subsequent motion for reconsideration. Barton timely appeals.
