SUMMARY STATEMENT

Edwards v. Lane, Docket No. 51237

This appeal involved the removal of Karla Lane as trustee of Trust A of the Lane Family Trust, stemming from allegations by co-trustees of Trust B that Karla breached her fiduciary duties. During the litigation, the district court removed Karla as trustee of Trust A after she refused to follow a court order requiring her to accept an offer to sell real property held by the Trust and to close on the sale by a certain date. Karla challenged the district court's order, arguing that the district court abused its discretion by removing her as trustee when her purpose in rejecting the purchase offer was to obtain a higher price. The Idaho Supreme Court declined to consider the merits of Karla's appeal, noting: (1) her briefing was deficient; (2) she supplied an insufficient record; (3) she failed to argue under the abuse of discretion standard; and (4) she made incoherent legal arguments unsupported by the law.
