SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Wilde Docket No. 51269

Robert Kenneth Wilde petitioned for review of the Court of Appeal's affirmation of the district court's restitution order. The district court ordered him to pay \$2,806.40 for the investigative costs incurred by the Boise City Police Department under Idaho's drug restitution statute, Idaho Code section 37-2732(k). The Court of Appeals affirmed the order of restitution. The Supreme Court granted review and held that the language of Wilde's plea agreement did not contain an appellate waiver. The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court on an alternate basis, holding that the district court's restitution order was supported by substantial and competent evidence, and the district court did not err when it ordered \$2,806.40 in restitution.
