

SUMMARY STATEMENT

State v. Jason Zane Garner, Docket No. 43493/43494

The Supreme Court affirmed the orders of the district court revoking Garner's probation and reinstating his underlying sentence of ten years, with six years fixed. The Supreme Court held that the requirement that a probation violation be "willful" as set forth in Idaho Criminal Rule 33(f) does not conflict with Idaho Code sections 19-2602, 19-2603 and 20-222 and is enforceable. The Supreme Court also held that the district court properly concluded that Garner willfully violated the terms of his probation.
