This expedited, permissive appeal involves a child custody dispute. Lisa M. Searle, nka Lisa Loosle appeals the Bingham County magistrate court's Memorandum Decision and Order which reversed the current child custody plan outlined in the 2013 Decision and Order between Ms. Searle and Dustin L. Searle. Specifically, Ms. Searle argues that the magistrate abused its discretion in determining that there was a substantial and material change in circumstances to warrant a change in custody. Ms. Searle also argues the magistrate abused its discretion when it determined that it was in the best interests of Child to reverse the existing custody order and give Mr. Searle physical custody during the school year.
