In a case arising out of Ada County, Teresa Lee Tollman (“Tollman”) appeals a district court’s order denying her motion for a restricted driver’s license. Specifically, Tollman argues that a district court erred when it failed to apply a 2015 amendment to Idaho Code section 18-8005(6)(d) (the “Amendment”). Tollman pled guilty to driving under the influence in 2013 (prior to the Amendment allowing defendants to apply for restricted driving privileges), but argues that the district court should have applied the Amendment because she filed her request for a restricted driver’s license after the Amendment was enacted.
